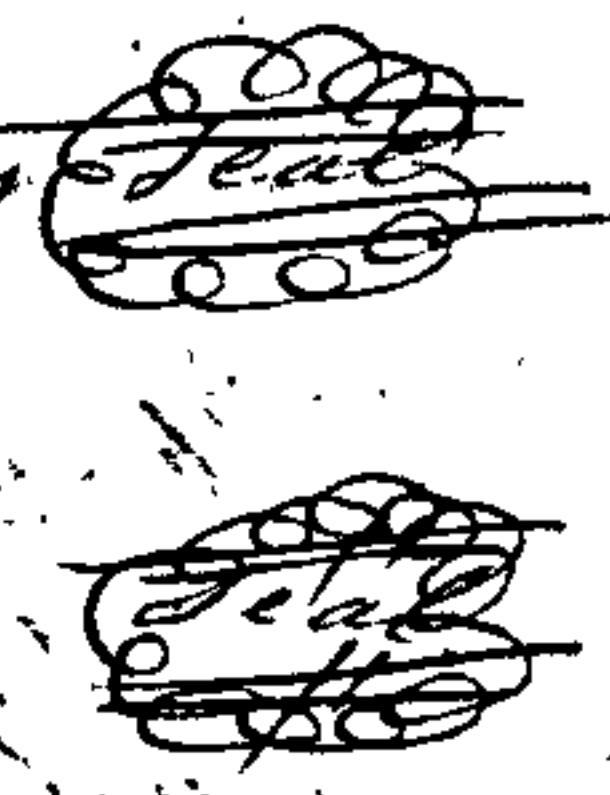


I know all men by these Presents that I Thomas Ives

and Seal this 30<sup>th</sup> day of September 1791

To all Christian People to whom these presents  
shall come I Humphry Smith of Craven County and State  
of North Carolina send Greeting, in our Lord Gods  
Everlasting Know ye. That I Humphry Smith for  
and in consideration of the love Good Will and affection  
which I have to and bear towards my loving Son Benja-  
min Smith of the aforesaid County have Given and  
Granted and by these Presents do freely clearly and  
absolutely give and Grant to the said Benjamin Smith  
his Heirs Executors and Administrators and assigns my  
Manner Plantation where I formerly did dwell at the
