This Indenture made this fifth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eleven Between Abram Johnson of the County of Craven and State of North Carolina of the one part and Christian Gibbs of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Abram Johnson for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and eighty nine Dollars to him in hand paid by the aforesaid Christian Gibbs before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof he hereby acknowledge therewith fully satisfied contented and paid. hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain sell and set over unto him the said Christian Gibbs his heirs and assigns three pieces of land containing two hundred and ten acres lying in the County and State aforesaid and Bounded as follows. One piece beginning on the North side of White houses Creek at David Johnsons Corner at the Creekside running with his line to the back line of the Patent then with the line of the patent North eighty seven degrees East to Richard Spencers line then with his line, to Drapers patent line then with Drapers patent line South fifteen West to the creek then up the windings of White houses Creek to the Beginning, being part of a patent granted to Abram Johnson bearing date December 22nd 1768 another piece beginning at a corner of David Joneses as a corner of the above patent and Running with the above patent line North eighty seven degrees East to Richard Spencers line then North fifty two degrees West one hundred and ninety poles then North seventy west to John Sigs line which was John Cornethers then with said line South forty five degrees

west
